GENERAL INFORMATION

REFUNDS /TRANSFERS - Written notice of cancellation or transfer must be received by NYCLA no later than one hour prior to the start of the program. A \$35 processing fee per course will be deducted from the refund for cancellations received less than five calendar days prior to the course date. No refunds will be issued after the program start time; program materials will be shipped within two weeks after completion of the program to registrants who have not notified the Institute of cancellation in a timely manner. A \$15 transfer fee will be charged for all transfer requests.
