

BREAKING NEWS: March 1, 2010 - The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) will appeal the October 2009 ruling by the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia that FTC's Red Flags regulations cannot be enforced against lawyers. The FTC argues that the regulations, designed to prevent identify theft, must apply to all "creditors" and includes lawyers in its definition of creditor.
